Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Edinburgh Royal Edinburgh

Arrival at Edinburgh Airport where your private driver guide welcomes the group for transfer into the historic capital. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Edinburgh Castle, exploring the Crown Jewels, Great Hall, and historic military galleries overlooking the city skyline. Lunch is reserved at The Witchery by the Castle, one of Edinburgh most celebrated heritage dining venues. In the afternoon enjoy pre-booked admission to The Palace of Holyroodhouse, followed by entry to the National Museum of Scotland offering exhibitions on Scottish history and innovation. Dinner is arranged at The Dome Restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

DAY 2

Highland Estates and Whisky Heritage

Depart Edinburgh after breakfast travelling north through Perthshire toward the Highland landscapes. The morning includes timed entry admission to Blair Castle and Gardens, a historic Highland estate presenting centuries of Scottish aristocratic life through its interiors and landscaped grounds. Lunch is reserved at The Atholl Arms Hotel in Pitlochry. In the afternoon continue to Edradour Distillery where guided tours and tastings introduce traditional whisky production. The programme continues with admission to Blair Athol Distillery Visitor Centre offering further insight into Highland whisky heritage. Dinner is pre-arranged at Fonab Castle Restaurant. Overnight in Pitlochry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Stirling Castle Departure

Depart Pitlochry after breakfast travelling south toward central Scotland. The morning features timed entry admission to Stirling Castle, one of Scotland most historically significant royal residences, where restored apartments and exhibitions illustrate the nation medieval power centre. Continue with entry to the National Wallace Monument presenting exhibitions dedicated to Scotland's national hero with panoramic views across the surrounding countryside. Lunch is reserved at The Portcullis Restaurant overlooking the castle esplanade. In the afternoon enjoy admission to The Kelpies Visitor Centre before transfer to Edinburgh Airport for onward departure.
