Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Edinburgh Historic Capital

Arrival at Edinburgh Airport where your private driver meets the group for transfer into the historic city centre. Begin with timed entry admission to Edinburgh Castle, exploring the Crown Jewels of Scotland, the Great Hall, and the Stone of Destiny through an engaging audio guided visit. Lunch is reserved at The Witchery by the Castle, one of the city's most atmospheric heritage dining rooms. In the afternoon enjoy pre-booked entry to The Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official Scottish residence of the monarchy, followed by admission to Dynamic Earth, an immersive science and geology experience ideal for families. Dinner is pre arranged at The Dome Restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

DAY 2

St Andrews Coastal Heritage

Depart Edinburgh after breakfast for the scenic drive across the Forth Road Bridge into the Kingdom of Fife. The morning features admission to the St Andrews Cathedral Visitor Centre and the historic cathedral ruins overlooking the North Sea. Continue to the British Golf Museum with pre-booked entry, offering engaging exhibits on Scotland's national sport. Lunch is reserved at The Seafood Ristorante overlooking St Andrews Bay. The afternoon includes admission to St Andrews Castle, where underground siege tunnels and coastal fortifications bring medieval Scotland to life. Return to Edinburgh for dinner at Timberyard Restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Highland Landscapes Loch Ness

Depart Edinburgh for the Highlands with a scenic route through Cairngorms National Park. The morning includes admission to Blair Castle and Gardens, a white turreted Highland estate with historic interiors and landscaped grounds. Lunch is reserved at The Atholl Arms Hotel in Pitlochry. Continue north to Loch Ness where pre-booked tickets allow boarding of a Loch Ness cruise departing from Fort Augustus, offering panoramic views across Scotland's most famous loch. The afternoon continues with admission to Urquhart Castle positioned above the water. Dinner is arranged at The Boathouse Restaurant. Overnight in Inverness.

DAY 4

Inverness Culloden Departure

Begin the morning with timed entry admission to Culloden Battlefield Visitor Centre, where immersive exhibitions explain one of the most significant events in Scottish history. Continue to Clava Cairns, a preserved Bronze Age burial complex that provides insight into Scotland's prehistoric past. Lunch is reserved at Rocpool Restaurant in Inverness. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Cawdor Castle and Gardens, a preserved Highland castle associated with Shakespeare's Macbeth. Following the visit, your driver transfers the family to Inverness Airport for onward departure, concluding the journey through Scotland's historic landscapes.
