Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Belfast – Maritime Heritage

Arrival at Belfast International Airport where your driver-guide meets the family for transfer into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Titanic Belfast, the award-winning museum interpreting the construction and legacy of the RMS Titanic. Lunch is reserved at The Muddlers Club Restaurant in Belfast's historic Cathedral Quarter. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the SS Nomadic, the last remaining White Star Line vessel, followed by entry to Belfast City Hall Visitor Exhibition, presenting the city's civic history. Dinner is arranged at OX Restaurant overlooking the River Lagan. Overnight Belfast.

DAY 2

Giant's Causeway & Antrim Coast

Depart Belfast travelling north along the scenic Causeway Coastal Route, one of Europe's most celebrated coastal drives. The morning includes timed-entry admission to the Giant's Causeway Visitor Experience, where volcanic basalt formations and local legend create one of Ireland's most iconic landscapes. Lunch is reserved at The Bushmills Inn Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy a guided tour and tasting at the Old Bushmills Distillery, the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, followed by admission to Dunluce Castle, dramatically perched above the Atlantic cliffs. Dinner is arranged at The Bushmills Inn. Overnight Bushmills.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Causeway Coast & Historic Estates

Begin the morning with admission to Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge Visitor Centre, where coastal views extend across the Atlantic to Rathlin Island. Continue with entry to Glenariff Forest Park Visitor Centre, exploring one of Northern Ireland's most beautiful natural landscapes. Lunch is reserved at The Bayview Hotel Restaurant overlooking the coast. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Mussenden Temple and Downhill Demesne, an 18th-century coastal estate with spectacular clifftop views. Return to the north coast where dinner is arranged at Harry's Shack Restaurant. Overnight Bushmills.

DAY 4

Walled City of Derry

Depart the Causeway Coast travelling west to the historic city of Derry~Londonderry. The morning includes admission to the Museum of Free Derry, presenting powerful exhibitions on the city's modern history. Continue with entry to the Tower Museum, interpreting the story of the city from its medieval origins to the present day. Lunch is reserved at The Walled City Brewery Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Guildhall Exhibition, followed by entry to the Siege Museum, exploring the historic 1689 siege. Dinner is arranged at Browns in Town Restaurant. Overnight Derry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Castles and Departure

Depart Derry travelling south through the countryside toward Belfast. The morning includes timed-entry admission to Hillsborough Castle and Gardens, the official royal residence in Northern Ireland, exploring the elegant state rooms and landscaped gardens. Continue with entry to the Ulster Museum, presenting art, natural history, and archaeology from across the region. Lunch is reserved at The Barking Dog Restaurant in Belfast. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Crumlin Road Gaol Visitor Experience, offering a compelling insight into Belfast's political history before transfer to Belfast International Airport for onward departure.
