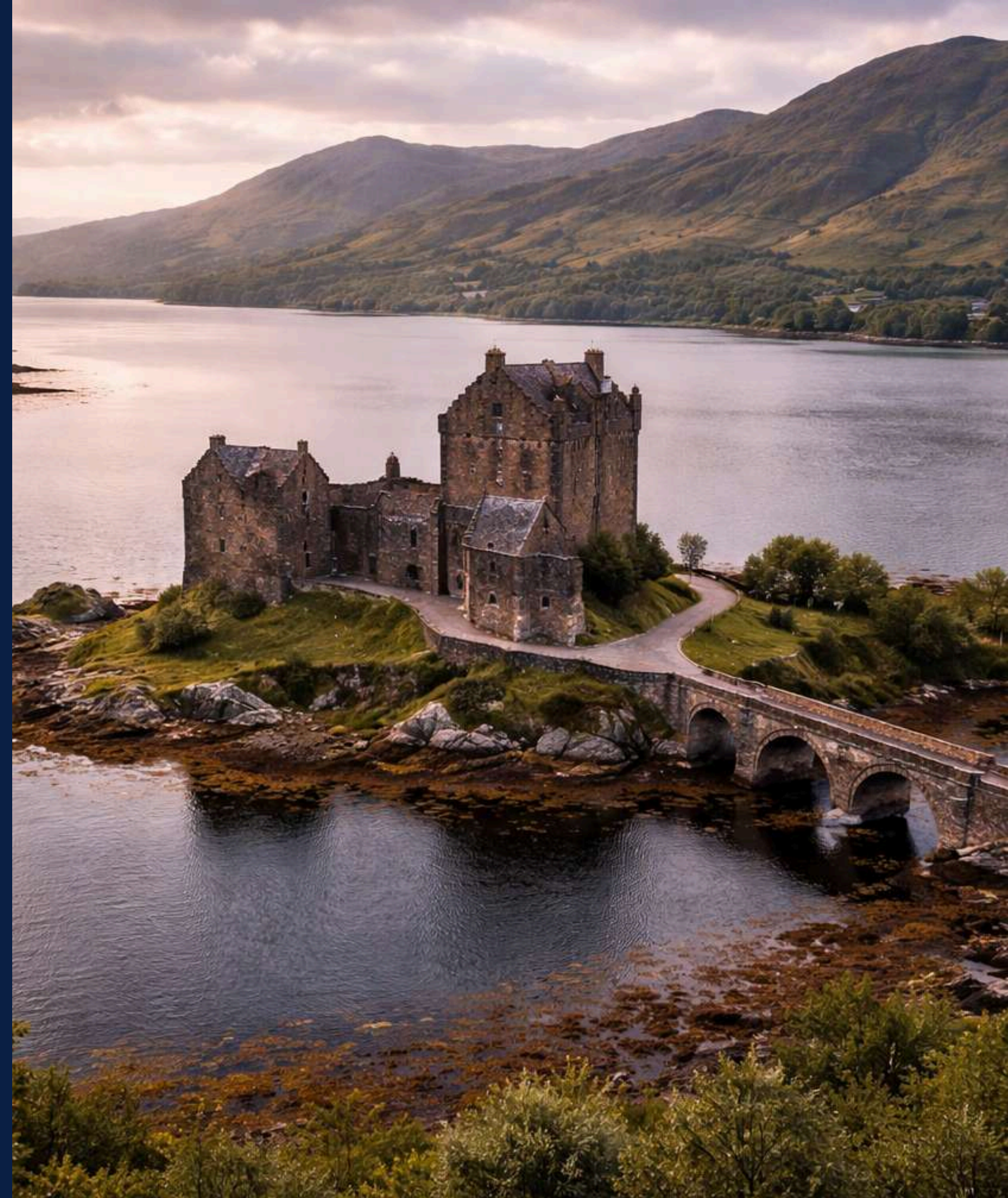

## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 1

#### Arrival in Edinburgh Historic Film Capital

Arrival at Edinburgh Airport where your private driver meets the family for transfer into the historic centre of Scotland capital. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Edinburgh Castle, whose dramatic skyline has appeared in numerous historical productions. Lunch is reserved at The Witchery by the Castle, a celebrated heritage dining venue. In the afternoon enjoy pre booked admission to the National Museum of Scotland, home to extensive collections used for historical research and film inspiration, followed by entry to the Scotch Whisky Experience for a guided presentation and tasting introduction. Dinner is arranged at The Dome Restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

### DAY 2

#### Fife Coast St Andrews and Historic Settings

Depart Edinburgh after breakfast crossing the Queensferry Crossing into the coastal landscapes of Fife. The morning includes admission to St Andrews Cathedral Visitor Centre, whose atmospheric ruins frequently appear in historical productions. Continue with pre booked entry to St Andrews Castle, famous for its dramatic cliffside ruins and medieval siege tunnels. Lunch is reserved at The Seafood Ristorante, overlooking the North Sea. The afternoon features admission to the British Golf Museum, offering engaging exhibits on Scotland sporting heritage. Return to Edinburgh where dinner is arranged at Timberyard Restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.



## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 3

#### Highland Landscapes Cairngorms and Estates

Depart Edinburgh travelling north through the scenic landscapes of Cairngorms National Park, frequently used as a backdrop for cinematic Highland scenery. The morning includes timed entry admission to Blair Castle and Gardens, a historic estate used in several television productions. Lunch is reserved at The Atholl Arms Hotel in Pitlochry. The afternoon continues with admission to the Highland Folk Museum, an open air heritage museum whose reconstructed village appeared in the television series Outlander. Continue north to Inverness where dinner is arranged at Rocpool Restaurant. Overnight in Inverness.

### DAY 4

#### Loch Ness and Highland Legends

The morning begins with admission to Culloden Battlefield Visitor Centre, an important filming location for historical drama recreations. Continue to nearby Clava Cairns, a prehistoric site whose distinctive stone circles inspired the fictional Craigh na Dun in Outlander. Lunch is reserved at The Boathouse Restaurant overlooking the Caledonian Canal. In the afternoon enjoy a pre booked Loch Ness Cruise from Fort Augustus, offering panoramic views across Scotland most famous loch, followed by admission to Urquhart Castle, dramatically positioned above the water and often featured in documentaries and film productions. Dinner is arranged at The Kitchen Brasserie. Overnight in Inverness.



## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 5

#### Highland Castles Departure

Depart Inverness after breakfast travelling south toward central Scotland. The morning includes timed entry admission to Doune Castle, one of Scotland most recognisable film locations, featured in Monty Python and the Holy Grail, Outlander, and Game of Thrones. Continue with admission to Stirling Castle, whose restored royal apartments present the grandeur of Scotland Renaissance court. Lunch is reserved at The Portcullis Restaurant overlooking the castle esplanade. In the afternoon enjoy entry to the National Wallace Monument before transfer to Edinburgh Airport for onward departure.
