Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in London Royal Foundations

Arrival at London Heathrow where your private driver meets the family for transfer into central London. The programme begins with timed entry admission to the Tower of London, where the Crown Jewels, White Tower, and medieval battlements introduce the foundations of British royal history. Lunch is reserved at Butlers Wharf Chop House overlooking Tower Bridge and the Thames. In the afternoon enjoy a pre booked Thames River Cruise to Westminster offering panoramic views of London historic skyline followed by timed admission to the London Eye. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy City Garden. Overnight in London.

DAY 2

Oxford and Blenheim Palace

Depart London after breakfast travelling west toward Oxfordshire. The morning includes timed entry admission to Blenheim Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, exploring the State Rooms and landscaped gardens. Lunch is reserved at The Orangery Restaurant within the palace estate. Continue into Oxford where pre booked entry to Christ Church College reveals its historic halls and cathedral followed by admission to the Ashmolean Museum, Britain first public museum with remarkable global collections. Return to London where dinner is arranged at Scotts Mayfair. Overnight in London.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Westminster and Kensington Departure

Begin the final morning with timed entry admission to Westminster Abbey, the coronation church of British monarchs and one of London most significant heritage sites. Continue with pre booked admission to the Churchill War Rooms presenting immersive exhibitions within the preserved underground headquarters of Britain wartime leadership. Lunch is reserved at The Goring Dining Room renowned for refined British cuisine. In the afternoon enjoy entry to Kensington Palace exploring the royal apartments and gardens before your driver transfers the family to London Heathrow Airport for onward departure.
