Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Dublin – Ireland's Culinary

Capital

On arrival at Dublin Airport, a private transfer brings guests into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Trinity College Dublin's Book of Kells Exhibition, including the Long Room Library. Lunch is reserved at The Woollen Mills Dining Room, showcasing modern Irish produce overlooking the River Liffey. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum, presenting Ireland's global diaspora through interactive exhibitions. Dinner is arranged at Chapter One Restaurant, renowned for refined contemporary Irish cuisine. Overnight Dublin.

DAY 2

Kilkenny & Ireland's Craft Traditions

Depart Dublin travelling south into Ireland's fertile agricultural heartland toward Kilkenny (approx. 1.5 hours). The morning includes timed-entry admission to Kilkenny Castle, exploring its restored Victorian interiors and riverside parklands. Continue with a cultural visit along the Medieval Mile, introducing the city's ecclesiastical and civic heritage. Lunch is reserved at Campagne Restaurant, celebrated for seasonal regional produce. In the afternoon, continue west toward County Kerry (approx. 3.5 hours) with comfort stops en route. Dinner is arranged at a carefully selected local restaurant. Overnight Killarney.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Ring of Kerry & Atlantic Produce

Begin the day with a scenic journey along the Ring of Kerry, where coastal landscapes and rural communities shape Ireland's Atlantic food culture. The morning follows a carefully paced route with selected viewpoints along the coastline and mountain passes, including a visit to a local artisan smokehouse to experience traditional curing techniques and regional produce. Lunch is reserved at The Lake Room Restaurant overlooking the Lakes of Killarney, showcasing seasonal ingredients. In the afternoon, continue the scenic circuit with curated coastal stops. Dinner is arranged at The Lime Tree Restaurant. Overnight Killarney.

DAY 4

Burren Landscapes & Coastal Ireland

Depart Killarney travelling north into County Clare along the Wild Atlantic Way (approx. 3 hours). The morning is centred on timed-entry admission to the Cliffs of Moher Visitor Experience, where dramatic Atlantic views define Ireland's west coast. Lunch is reserved at The Falls Hotel Restaurant in Ennistymon, showcasing seasonal local produce. In the afternoon, continue directly to Galway, allowing for a smooth and unhurried journey. Dinner is arranged at Aniar Restaurant, known for innovative cuisine rooted in Atlantic ingredients. Overnight Galway.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Connemara & Atlantic Heritage

After breakfast, depart Galway with a private driver travelling west into the landscapes of Connemara (approx. 1.5 hours), known for its mountains, lakes and Atlantic coastline. The morning includes timed-entry admission to Kylemore Abbey and Gardens, exploring the restored Benedictine monastery, Victorian walled gardens and lakeside setting. Lunch is reserved at a carefully selected local restaurant showcasing regional produce. In the afternoon, continue with a curated Connemara food-led experience, highlighting artisan producers and traditional flavours. Return to Galway where dinner is arranged at a leading local restaurant. Overnight Galway.

DAY 6

Return to Dublin – Departure

Depart Galway travelling east toward Dublin Airport (approx. 2.5 hours). The morning includes admission to the Irish National Stud and Japanese Gardens, exploring Ireland's renowned thoroughbred heritage alongside its landscaped grounds. Lunch is reserved at The Green Barn Restaurant in County Kildare, timed to align comfortably with onward travel. Following lunch, continue directly to Dublin Airport via private transfer, ensuring a smooth and timely arrival for departure formalities.
