Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Belfast – Maritime and Modern Heritage

Arrival at Belfast International Airport where your driver-guide welcomes the family and transfers them into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Titanic Belfast, the immersive museum telling the story of the shipyard where the Titanic was built. Lunch is reserved at The Muddlers Club Restaurant in the Cathedral Quarter. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the SS Nomadic, the final surviving White Star Line vessel, followed by entry to Crumlin Road Gaol Visitor Experience, presenting Belfast's complex political past. Dinner is arranged at OX Restaurant overlooking the River Lagan. Overnight Belfast.

DAY 2

Game of Thrones Landscapes & Causeway Coast

Depart Belfast travelling north along the spectacular Causeway Coastal Route. The morning includes admission to the Giant's Causeway Visitor Experience, where the basalt columns form one of Ireland's most iconic landscapes and a recognised filming backdrop. Lunch is reserved at The Bushmills Inn Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy a guided tour and tasting at the Old Bushmills Distillery, the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, followed by admission to Dunluce Castle, whose dramatic coastal ruins inspired several cinematic settings. Dinner is arranged at The Bushmills Inn. Overnight Bushmills.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Coastal Film Locations & Historic Estates

Begin the morning with admission to the Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge Visitor Centre, offering sweeping views across the Atlantic coastline and nearby filming locations. Continue to Ballintoy Harbour, recognised globally as a filming site for Game of Thrones. Lunch is reserved at The Bayview Hotel Restaurant overlooking the Antrim Coast. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Mussenden Temple and Downhill Demesne, an elegant 18th-century coastal estate frequently used for film and television productions. Continue west to Derry where dinner is arranged at Browns in Town Restaurant. Overnight Derry.

DAY 4

Walled City of Derry & Cultural Identity

The morning begins with admission to the Tower Museum, presenting the city's story from its medieval origins to the modern era. Continue with entry to the Museum of Free Derry, offering an important interpretation of Northern Ireland's civil rights movement. Lunch is reserved at The Walled City Brewery Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Guildhall Exhibition, followed by entry to the Siege Museum, exploring the historic 1689 siege of Derry. Dinner is arranged at The Exchange Restaurant overlooking the Peace Bridge. Overnight Derry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Royal Hillsborough & Departure

Depart Derry travelling south toward Belfast. The morning includes timed-entry admission to Hillsborough Castle and Gardens, the official royal residence in Northern Ireland, exploring elegant state rooms and landscaped grounds. Continue with entry to the Ulster Folk Museum, where reconstructed cottages and workshops interpret traditional rural life. Lunch is reserved at The Pheasant Restaurant in Hillsborough village. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Ulster Museum, presenting art, archaeology, and natural history before transfer to Belfast International Airport for onward departure.
