Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Day 1 Arrival in Cardiff Welsh Food and Heritage

Arrival at Cardiff Airport where your driver guide welcomes the group and transfers them into the Welsh capital. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Cardiff Castle exploring its Roman walls and Victorian interiors. Continue with entry to the National Museum Cardiff presenting Welsh art natural history and regional identity. Lunch is reserved within Cardiff Market introducing traditional Welsh produce and artisan foods. In the afternoon enjoy admission to St Fagans National Museum of History showcasing Welsh life through preserved buildings and demonstrations. Dinner is arranged at Heaneys Restaurant highlighting Welsh cuisine. Overnight in Cardiff.

DAY 2

Brecon Beacons and Rural Produce

Depart Cardiff travelling into the landscapes of Brecon Beacons National Park. The morning begins with admission to the National Showcaves Centre for Wales exploring limestone caverns. Continue with entry to Brecon Cathedral and Heritage Centre presenting regional history. Lunch is reserved at The Felin Fach Griffin Restaurant specialising in seasonal Welsh produce. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Penderyn Distillery Visitor Centre where guided tastings introduce Welsh whisky. Dinner is arranged at The Walnut Tree Restaurant. Overnight in Brecon.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Pembrokeshire Coast and Maritime Traditions

Travel west into Pembrokeshire Coast National Park known for Atlantic scenery and coastal heritage. The morning features admission to St Davids Cathedral one of Britain most significant religious landmarks. Continue with entry to St Davids Bishop Palace Exhibition interpreting medieval life. Lunch is reserved at The Shed Restaurant in Porthgain specialising in seafood. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Pembroke Castle birthplace of Henry VII and one of Wales most impressive fortresses. Dinner is arranged at Grove of Narberth Restaurant presenting regional cuisine. Overnight in Pembrokeshire.

DAY 4

North Wales Estates and Coastal Gardens

Depart Pembrokeshire travelling north through the countryside toward North Wales. The morning includes timed entry admission to Caernarfon Castle a UNESCO World Heritage Site and medieval fortress. Lunch is reserved at The Black Boy Inn Restaurant one of the oldest inns in Wales. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Bodnant Garden overlooking the Conwy Valley followed by entry to Plas Mawr Elizabethan Townhouse offering insight into Tudor life. Dinner is arranged at Pale Hall Restaurant showcasing Welsh ingredients. Overnight in Snowdonia.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Snowdonia Heritage and Departure

The final morning begins with admission to the National Slate Museum in Llanberis presenting the industrial traditions that shaped North Wales. Continue with entry to Llechwedd Slate Caverns where exhibitions and underground tours reveal quarrying history. Lunch is reserved at The Heights Restaurant overlooking Llyn Padarn and the Snowdonia mountains. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Penrhyn Castle and Gardens a National Trust estate combining architecture and landscapes before transfer toward Manchester or Liverpool Airport for departure.
