## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 1

#### Capital Heritage

On arrival at Dublin Airport, a private transfer brings guests into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Trinity College Dublin's Book of Kells Exhibition, including the Long Room Library. Lunch is reserved at The Woollen Mills Dining Room overlooking the River Liffey. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Dublin Castle State Apartments, exploring its historic interiors and ceremonial rooms. An optional visit to the Guinness Storehouse may be considered subject to arrival time. Dinner is arranged at Chapter One Restaurant. Overnight Dublin.

### DAY 2

#### Wicklow Mountains & Glendalough

Depart Dublin travelling south into the landscapes of the Wicklow Mountains National Park. The morning includes admission to the Glendalough Visitor Centre, interpreting the historic monastic settlement founded by St Kevin. Continue with entry to Powerscourt House and Gardens, one of Ireland's most celebrated country estates overlooking the Sugar Loaf Mountain. Lunch is reserved at The Avoca Terrace Café within the estate. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Powerscourt Distillery, where guided tours introduce Ireland's whiskey-making heritage. Return to Dublin where dinner is arranged at The Ivy Dawson Street. Overnight Dublin.



## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 3

#### Atlantic Coast & Cliffs of Moher

Depart Dublin travelling west toward the Atlantic coast (approx. 3 hours). The morning is centred on timed-entry admission to the Cliffs of Moher Visitor Experience, offering dramatic views across the Wild Atlantic Way. Lunch is reserved at The Falls Hotel Restaurant in Ennistymon, allowing for a well-paced break en route. In the afternoon, continue the journey north toward Galway, ensuring a smooth and unhurried arrival into the city. Dinner is arranged at Aniar Restaurant, known for refined cuisine inspired by Atlantic produce. Overnight Galway.

### DAY 4

#### Connemara & Departure

After breakfast, the morning is spent in Galway with admission to Galway City Museum, presenting the city's maritime and cultural heritage through curated exhibitions. Continue with a visit to St Nicholas' Collegiate Church, one of Ireland's finest medieval parish churches. Lunch is reserved at a centrally located restaurant showcasing regional produce. In the afternoon, depart Galway with a private transfer travelling east toward Dublin Airport (approx. 2.5 hours), ensuring a smooth and timely arrival for departure formalities.
