Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in London Foundations of British History

Arrival at London Heathrow where your private driver-guide meets you on arrival for a seamless transfer into central London. The programme begins with the opportunity to explore the Tower of London, home to the Crown Jewels and one of London's most historic landmarks, where medieval fortress galleries introduce England's royal and political history. Lunch is enjoyed at Butlers Wharf Chop House overlooking Tower Bridge. In the afternoon, enjoy a Thames River Cruise to Westminster, providing a scenic introduction to London's historic skyline, followed by the opportunity to experience the London Eye, offering panoramic views across the capital. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy City Garden. Overnight in London.

DAY 2

Oxford and Academic England

Depart London travelling west toward Oxford. The morning begins in Oxford with a visit to Christ Church College, one of the university's most historic colleges and cathedral foundations. Continue to the Ashmolean Museum, where collections span centuries of art and antiquities. Lunch is reserved at The Old Parsonage Restaurant. This afternoon, experience Blenheim Palace, a UNESCO-listed estate and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, exploring the State Rooms and landscaped parkland. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy Oxford Brasserie. Overnight in Oxford.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Northern Heritage York

Travel north to the historic city of York. The morning includes admission to York Minster, one of the largest Gothic cathedrals in Northern Europe, with medieval stained glass. Continue with entry to the Jorvik Viking Centre, where exhibitions reconstruct Viking-age York. Lunch is reserved at The Ivy St Helens Square Restaurant. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to the National Railway Museum, home to Britain's most important collection of historic locomotives and engineering innovation. Dinner is arranged at Roots York Restaurant. Overnight in York.

DAY 4

Northern Castles and Departure

Depart York, travelling south toward central England. The morning features timed entry admission to Warwick Castle, where restored interiors and exhibitions present England's feudal history. Continue with entry to Shakespeare's Birthplace in Stratford upon Avon, exploring the Tudor home of the playwright. Lunch is reserved at The Arden Hotel Restaurant. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Anne Hathaway's Cottage, a preserved farmhouse surrounded by gardens, before transfer to London Heathrow Airport for onward departure.
