Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in London Historic Landmarks

Arrival at London Heathrow where your driver guide meets the group for transfer into central London. The programme begins with the opportunity to explore the Tower of London, home to the Crown Jewels and centuries of royal history, including its medieval fortress galleries overlooking the Thames. Lunch is reserved at Butlers Wharf Chop House offering British cuisine with views of Tower Bridge. In the afternoon enjoy a Thames River Cruise to Westminster followed by the opportunity to experience the London Eye, offering panoramic views across the capital. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy City Garden showcasing contemporary English dining. Overnight in London.

DAY 2

Westminster and Cultural London

The morning begins with a visit to Westminster Abbey, the coronation church of British monarchs and one of the nation's most significant historic landmarks. Continue to the Churchill War Rooms, where immersive galleries reveal Britain's wartime leadership beneath Whitehall. Lunch is reserved at The Goring Dining Room, long associated with British hospitality. In the afternoon, explore the Victoria and Albert Museum before continuing to Kensington Palace, a royal residence rich in history. Dinner is arranged at Scotts Mayfair. Overnight in London.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Oxford and Blenheim Palace

Depart London travelling west toward Oxfordshire. The morning begins with a visit to Christ Church College, one of Oxford's most historic colleges and cathedral foundations. Continue to the Ashmolean Museum, where collections span centuries of global art and antiquities. Lunch is reserved at The Old Parsonage Restaurant. This afternoon, experience Blenheim Palace, a UNESCO-listed estate and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, exploring the State Rooms and landscaped parkland. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy Oxford Brasserie. Overnight in Oxford.

DAY 4

Bath and Georgian Elegance

Travel south through the countryside to Bath. The morning begins at the Roman Baths, one of Britain's most important historic sites, exploring the preserved bathing complex and museum galleries. Continue to Bath Abbey, an architectural landmark at the heart of the city. Lunch is reserved at The Ivy Bath Brasserie. In the afternoon, visit No.1 Royal Crescent, a restored Georgian townhouse, with an optional visit to the Jane Austen Centre for those interested in the author's connection to the city. Dinner is arranged at The Pump Room Restaurant. Overnight in Bath.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Stonehenge and Departure

Depart Bath travelling east through the Wiltshire countryside. The morning includes a visit to Stonehenge, one of Europe's most significant prehistoric monuments. Continue to Salisbury and Salisbury Cathedral, home to one of the original Magna Carta manuscripts and an outstanding example of Gothic architecture. Lunch is reserved at The Chapter House Restaurant near the cathedral close. In the afternoon, explore Old Sarum, the historic hilltop settlement overlooking Salisbury, before transfer to London Heathrow Airport for onward departure.
