Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in London and Royal Foundations

Arrival at London Heathrow, where your driver guide welcomes the group and transfers them into central London. The programme begins with timed entry admission to the Tower of London, where the Crown Jewels and medieval fortress galleries introduce England's royal past. Lunch is reserved at Butlers Wharf Chop House overlooking Tower Bridge. In the afternoon, enjoy a Thames River Cruise to Westminster offering panoramic views of the capital's historic skyline, followed by timed admission to the London Eye. Dinner is pre-arranged at The Ivy City Garden. Overnight in London.

DAY 2

Royal London and Cultural Landmarks

The morning begins with timed entry admission to Westminster Abbey, including a private guided exploration, Britain's coronation church and one of its most important historic monuments. Continue to the Churchill War Rooms where exhibitions reveal Britain's wartime leadership beneath Whitehall. Lunch is reserved at The Goring Dining Room, long associated with royal London. In the afternoon enjoy pre-booked admission to Kensington Palace exploring the royal apartments and gardens. Dinner is arranged at Scott's Mayfair. Overnight in London.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Oxford and the Traditions of Academic England

Depart London travelling west toward Oxford. The morning includes pre-booked entry to Christ Church College, one of the university's most historic colleges and cathedral foundations, followed by a private guided exploration of Oxford's historic colleges and academic heritage. Continue with admission to the Ashmolean Museum presenting collections spanning centuries of global culture. Lunch is reserved at The Old Parsonage Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Blenheim Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, exploring the State Rooms and landscaped parkland. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy Oxford Brasserie. Overnight in Oxford.

DAY 4

Shakespeare's England and Warwick Castle

Travel north to Stratford-upon-Avon, birthplace of William Shakespeare. The morning includes admission to Shakespeare's Birthplace, where exhibitions present the playwright's early life and Tudor England. Continue with entry to Anne Hathaway's Cottage, a preserved farmhouse surrounded by gardens. Lunch is reserved at The Arden Hotel Restaurant. The afternoon features admission to Warwick Castle, where restored interiors and exhibitions recreate England's feudal past. Continue south into the Cotswolds, where dinner is arranged at The Wild Rabbit Restaurant. Overnight in the Cotswolds.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Bath and the Elegance of Georgian England

Depart the Cotswolds, travelling to Bath, one of England's most elegant historic cities. The morning begins with timed entry admission to the Roman Baths, exploring the preserved bathing complex and museum galleries. Continue with entry to Bath Abbey, an architectural landmark at the centre of the city. Lunch is reserved at The Ivy Bath Brasserie. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to the Jane Austen Centre, presenting the cultural world of Regency England, followed by entry to No 1 Royal Crescent, a restored Georgian townhouse museum. Dinner is arranged at The Pump Room Restaurant. Overnight in Bath.

DAY 6

Stonehenge and the Cathedral City of Salisbury

Travel east through the Wiltshire countryside. The morning includes timed entry admission to Stonehenge, the prehistoric monument that remains one of Europe's most significant archaeological sites. Continue to Salisbury, where entry to Salisbury Cathedral reveals a notable example of English Gothic architecture and a preserved copy of the Magna Carta. Lunch is reserved at The Chapter House Restaurant. The afternoon includes admission to Mompesson House, a preserved Georgian residence featured in period productions. Dinner is arranged at The Ivy Winchester Brasserie. Overnight in Winchester.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 7

Portsmouth and Britain's Naval Legacy

Depart Winchester for England's historic naval coast. The morning includes admission to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard where visitors explore HMS Victory, the Mary Rose Museum, and HMS Warrior, presenting the evolution of Britain's naval power. Lunch is reserved at The Brasserie at No.5 within the dockyard complex. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Spinnaker Tower offering views across Portsmouth Harbour and the Solent. Return to Winchester for dinner at a centrally located restaurant. Overnight in Winchester.

DAY 8

Cambridge and England's Academic Heritage

Depart Winchester travelling north toward Cambridge, one of England's great university cities. The morning includes admission to King's College Chapel, renowned for its Gothic architecture and choral tradition. Continue with entry to the Fitzwilliam Museum whose collections span art, manuscripts and antiquities. Lunch is reserved at The Ivy Cambridge Brasserie. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Cambridge University Botanic Garden presenting a collection of plants linked to scientific discovery. Continue to London where dinner is arranged at The Savoy Grill. Overnight in London.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 9

London's Cultural Treasures and Departure

The final morning focuses on London's cultural institutions. Begin with timed entry admission to the British Museum, home to one of the world's greatest collections of human history and civilisation. Continue with entry to St Paul's Cathedral exploring the dome, crypt and galleries. A farewell lunch is reserved at The Ned Restaurant located in a historic banking hall. Transfer to London Heathrow Airport for onward departure.
