Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Dublin – Ireland’s Cultural Capital

Arrival at Dublin Airport where your driver-guide welcomes the group and transfers them into the historic city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Trinity College Dublin’s Book of Kells Exhibition, including the magnificent Long Room Library. Lunch is reserved at The Woollen Mills Dining Room overlooking the River Liffey. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Dublin Castle State Apartments, followed by entry to the Guinness Storehouse, where immersive exhibitions present Ireland’s brewing heritage. Dinner is arranged at Chapter One Restaurant, celebrated for refined contemporary Irish cuisine. Overnight Dublin.

DAY 2

Medieval Kilkenny & Ireland’s Heritage

Depart Dublin travelling south through the Irish countryside toward Kilkenny (approx. 1.5 hours). The morning includes timed-entry admission to Kilkenny Castle, exploring restored interiors and riverside parklands overlooking the River Nore. Continue with a cultural visit along the Medieval Mile, introducing Kilkenny’s ecclesiastical and civic heritage. Lunch is reserved at Campagne Restaurant, known for refined regional cuisine. In the afternoon, continue west toward County Kerry (approx. 3.5 hours) with comfort stops en route. Dinner is arranged at a carefully selected local restaurant. Overnight Killarney.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Ring of Kerry & Atlantic Landscapes

Begin the day travelling along the scenic Ring of Kerry, one of Ireland's most celebrated coastal touring routes, following a carefully paced circuit with selected coastal and mountain viewpoints. The morning includes admission to Muckross House and Gardens within Killarney National Park, a beautifully preserved Victorian estate overlooking the lakes. Lunch is reserved at The Lake Room Restaurant in Killarney. In the afternoon, continue the scenic route with curated stops along the Atlantic coastline. Dinner is arranged at The Lime Tree Restaurant. Overnight Killarney.

DAY 4

Cliffs of Moher & Galway

Depart Killarney travelling north toward County Clare along the Wild Atlantic Way (approx. 3 hours). The morning is centred on timed-entry admission to the Cliffs of Moher Visitor Experience, where dramatic Atlantic views stretch across Ireland's west coast. Lunch is reserved at The Falls Hotel Restaurant in Ennistymon, timed to allow a relaxed visit. In the afternoon, continue directly to Galway for a smooth arrival into the city. Dinner is arranged at Aniar Restaurant, known for contemporary cuisine inspired by Atlantic produce. Overnight Galway.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Connemara & Departure

After breakfast, the morning is spent in Galway with admission to Galway City Museum, presenting the city's maritime and cultural heritage through curated exhibitions. Continue with a visit to St Nicholas' Collegiate Church, one of Ireland's finest medieval parish churches. Lunch is reserved at a centrally located restaurant showcasing regional produce. In the afternoon, depart Galway with a private transfer travelling east toward Dublin Airport (approx. 2.5 hours), ensuring a smooth and timely arrival for departure formalities.
