Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Belfast – Understanding the City

Arrival at Belfast International Airport where your driver-guide meets the group and transfers them into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Titanic Belfast, the award-winning museum interpreting the construction and legacy of the RMS Titanic. Lunch is reserved at The Muddlers Club Restaurant in the Cathedral Quarter. In the afternoon visit Crumlin Road Gaol Visitor Experience, presenting the prison's complex political history, followed by entry to the Ulster Museum, whose galleries explore archaeology, art, and the history of Northern Ireland. Dinner is arranged at OX Restaurant. Overnight Belfast.

DAY 2

Political History and Civic Belfast

Begin the morning with admission to Belfast City Hall Visitor Exhibition, where displays introduce the city's industrial rise and civic heritage. Continue to the SS Nomadic, the last remaining White Star Line vessel and tender to the Titanic. Lunch is reserved at The Barking Dog Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy entry to the Museum of Orange Heritage at Schomberg House, presenting the cultural traditions of unionist identity, followed by admission to W5 Science & Discovery Centre, an interactive science museum suitable for all ages. Dinner is arranged at Deanes EIPIC Restaurant. Overnight Belfast.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Antrim Coast & Geological Landscapes

Depart Belfast travelling north along the scenic Causeway Coastal Route. The morning includes timed-entry admission to the Giant's Causeway Visitor Experience, where volcanic basalt columns and coastal geology create Northern Ireland's most iconic natural landmark. Lunch is reserved at The Bushmills Inn Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy a guided tour and tasting at the Old Bushmills Distillery, the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, followed by admission to Dunluce Castle, dramatically positioned above the Atlantic cliffs. Dinner is arranged at The Bushmills Inn. Overnight Bushmills.

DAY 4

Derry~Londonderry – History and Identity

Depart the north coast travelling west to the historic city of Derry~Londonderry. The morning includes admission to the Tower Museum, presenting the city's history from its medieval foundations to modern times. Continue with entry to the Museum of Free Derry, offering a powerful interpretation of the civil rights era and the events of Bloody Sunday. Lunch is reserved at The Walled City Brewery Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Siege Museum, explaining the historic 1689 siege, followed by entry to the Guildhall Exhibition. Dinner is arranged at Browns in Town Restaurant. Overnight Derry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Castles and Departure

Depart Derry travelling south toward Belfast. The morning includes timed-entry admission to Hillsborough Castle and Gardens, the official royal residence in Northern Ireland, exploring elegant state rooms and landscaped gardens. Continue with entry to The Argory, a beautifully preserved National Trust estate presenting Victorian country life. Lunch is reserved at The Pheasant Restaurant near Hillsborough. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Ulster Folk Museum, where reconstructed buildings interpret traditional rural life before transfer to Belfast International Airport for onward departure.
