Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Belfast – Maritime City Foundations

Arrival at Belfast International Airport where your driver-guide welcomes the group and transfers them into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Titanic Belfast, the award-winning museum interpreting the construction and legacy of the RMS Titanic. Lunch is reserved at The Muddlers Club Restaurant in the historic Cathedral Quarter. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the SS Nomadic, the last remaining White Star Line vessel, followed by entry to the Ulster Museum, whose galleries explore art, archaeology, and regional history. Dinner is arranged at OX Restaurant overlooking the River Lagan. Overnight Belfast.

DAY 2

Belfast Heritage & Civic Landmarks

Begin the morning with admission to Belfast City Hall Visitor Exhibition, where displays introduce the city's industrial heritage and civic history. Continue with entry to Crumlin Road Gaol Visitor Experience, offering powerful interpretation of the prison's political past. Lunch is reserved at The Barking Dog Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to W5 Science & Discovery Centre, an interactive science museum suitable for visitors of all ages, followed by entry to St George's Market Food Experience, showcasing regional produce and culinary traditions. Dinner is arranged at Deanes EIPIC Restaurant. Overnight Belfast.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Causeway Coastal Route & Bushmills

Depart Belfast travelling north along the spectacular Causeway Coastal Route. The morning includes timed-entry admission to the Giant's Causeway Visitor Experience, where volcanic basalt formations create Northern Ireland's most famous natural landmark. Lunch is reserved at The Bushmills Inn Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy a guided tour and tasting at the Old Bushmills Distillery, the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, followed by admission to Dunluce Castle, dramatically positioned above Atlantic cliffs. Dinner is arranged at The Bushmills Inn. Overnight Bushmills.

DAY 4

Causeway Coast Landscapes

The day begins with admission to the Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge Visitor Centre, where coastal views extend across the Atlantic to Rathlin Island. Continue with entry to Glenariff Forest Park Visitor Centre, exploring one of Northern Ireland's most scenic glens. Lunch is reserved at The Bayview Hotel Restaurant overlooking the Antrim Coast. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Mussenden Temple and Downhill Demesne, an 18th-century coastal estate with spectacular clifftop views. Continue west toward Derry where dinner is arranged at Browns in Town Restaurant. Overnight Derry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Derry~Londonderry & Historic Identity

Begin the morning with admission to the Tower Museum, presenting the story of Derry from its medieval foundations to the modern era. Continue with entry to the Museum of Free Derry, offering powerful interpretation of the city's civil rights history. Lunch is reserved at The Walled City Brewery Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Guildhall Exhibition, followed by entry to the Siege Museum, exploring the events of the historic 1689 siege. Dinner is arranged at The Exchange Restaurant overlooking the Peace Bridge. Overnight Derry.

DAY 6

Armagh & Departure

Depart Derry travelling south toward Armagh, the ecclesiastical capital of Ireland. The morning includes admission to the Navan Centre & Fort, interpreting the mythological and archaeological history of ancient Ulster. Continue with entry to the Armagh Observatory and Planetarium, offering engaging exhibitions on astronomy and scientific discovery. Lunch is reserved at The Moody Boar Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to St Patrick's Cathedral (Church of Ireland) before transfer to Belfast International Airport for onward departure.
