Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Belfast – Maritime and Industrial Heritage

Arrival at Belfast International Airport where your driver-guide meets the group for transfer into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Titanic Belfast, the world-class museum exploring the ship's construction and Belfast's industrial heritage. Lunch is reserved at The Muddlers Club Restaurant in the Cathedral Quarter. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the SS Nomadic, the last remaining White Star Line vessel, followed by entry to Crumlin Road Gaol Visitor Experience, presenting the complex political history of the region. Dinner is arranged at OX Restaurant overlooking the River Lagan. Overnight Belfast.

DAY 2

Civic Belfast and Cultural Identity

Begin the morning with admission to Belfast City Hall Visitor Exhibition, introducing the city's civic development and industrial growth. Continue to the Ulster Museum, whose galleries explore archaeology, art, and the history of Northern Ireland. Lunch is reserved at The Barking Dog Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to W5 Science & Discovery Centre, an interactive learning experience suitable for all ages, followed by entry to St George's Market Food Experience, showcasing regional produce and culinary traditions. Dinner is arranged at Deanes EIPIC Restaurant, known for contemporary Irish cuisine. Overnight Belfast.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Causeway Coastal Route & Bushmills

Depart Belfast travelling north along the spectacular Causeway Coastal Route. The morning includes timed-entry admission to the Giant's Causeway Visitor Experience, where dramatic basalt columns and geological interpretation explain this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lunch is reserved at The Bushmills Inn Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy a guided tour and tasting at the Old Bushmills Distillery, the world's oldest licensed whiskey distillery, followed by admission to Dunluce Castle, dramatically positioned on Atlantic cliffs. Dinner is arranged at The Bushmills Inn. Overnight Bushmills.

DAY 4

Causeway Coast Landscapes & Derry

Begin the morning with admission to the Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge Visitor Centre, where coastal viewpoints overlook the North Atlantic. Continue with entry to Mussenden Temple and Downhill Demesne, an elegant 18th-century coastal estate with spectacular clifftop scenery. Lunch is reserved at The Bayview Hotel Restaurant overlooking the Antrim Coast. In the afternoon travel west to Derry~Londonderry where admission to the Tower Museum introduces the city's layered history. Dinner is arranged at Browns in Town Restaurant. Overnight Derry.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Derry Heritage and Departure

The final morning begins with admission to the Museum of Free Derry, presenting the civil rights era and the events of Bloody Sunday. Continue with entry to the Guildhall Exhibition, interpreting the political and cultural development of the walled city. Lunch is reserved at The Walled City Brewery Restaurant. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Siege Museum, which explains the historic 1689 siege that shaped the city's identity. Following the visit, transfer to Belfast International Airport for onward departure.
