Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Dublin – Ireland’s Historic Capital

Arrival at Dublin Airport where your private driver-guide welcomes the family and transfers them into the city centre. The programme begins with timed-entry admission to Trinity College Dublin’s Book of Kells Exhibition, including the Long Room Library. Lunch is reserved at The Woollen Mills Dining Room overlooking the River Liffey. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Dublin Castle State Apartments, followed by entry to EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum, an immersive interpretation of Ireland’s global story. Dinner is arranged at Chapter One Restaurant, known for refined contemporary Irish cuisine. Overnight Dublin.

DAY 2

Kilkenny & Ireland’s Medieval Heart

Depart Dublin travelling south through the Irish countryside to Kilkenny. The morning includes timed-entry admission to Kilkenny Castle, exploring its restored Victorian interiors and landscaped gardens. Continue with a short walk along the Medieval Mile, linking the city’s principal historic landmarks. Lunch is reserved at Campagne Restaurant, one of Ireland’s leading regional dining venues. In the afternoon, continue west toward County Kerry (approx. 3.5 hours) with comfort stops en route. Dinner is arranged at a carefully selected local restaurant. Overnight Killarney.

DAY 3

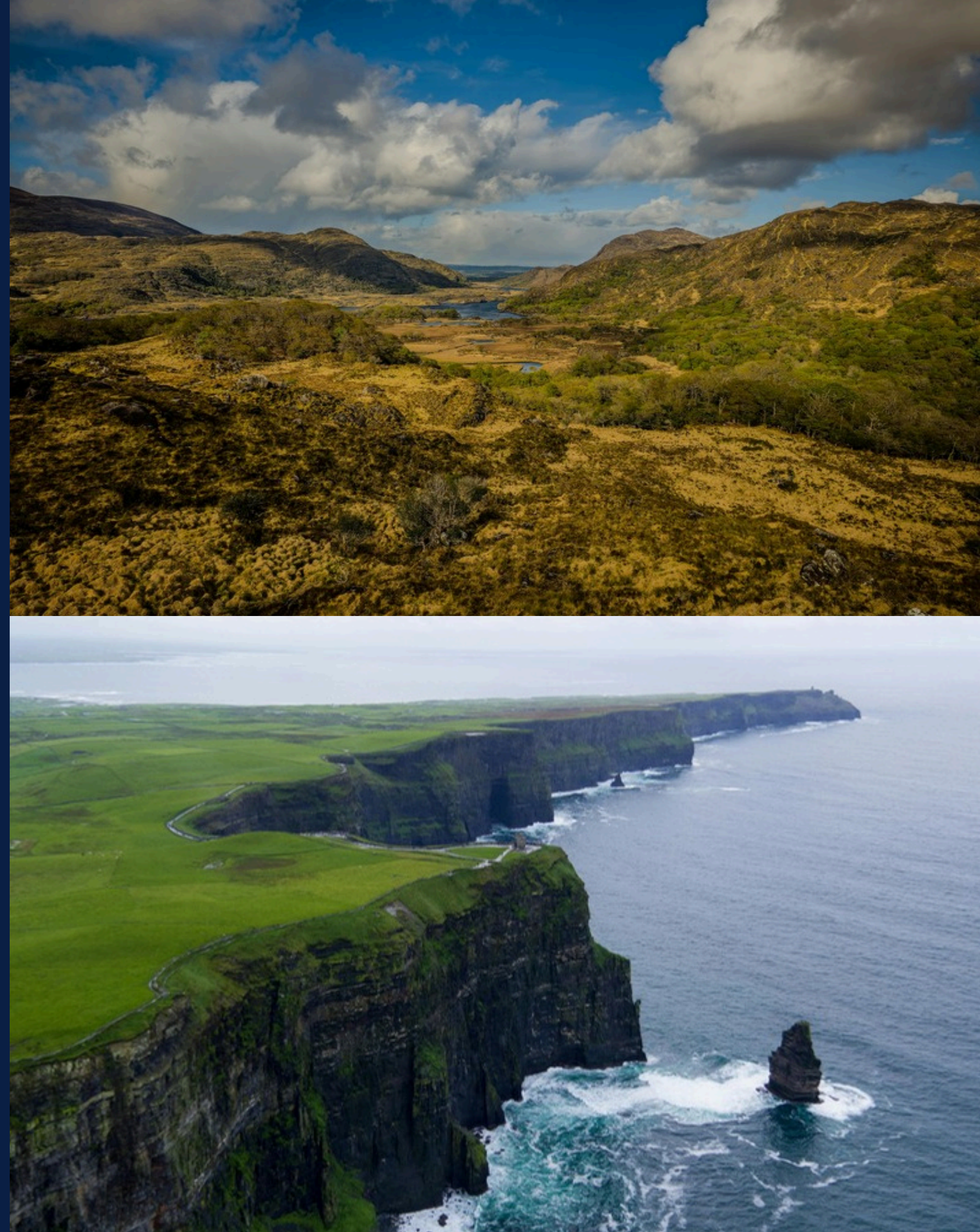
Ring of Kerry & Atlantic Landscapes

Begin the day travelling through the spectacular scenery of the Ring of Kerry, one of Ireland's most celebrated coastal routes, following a carefully paced circuit with panoramic coastal and mountain viewpoints. The morning includes admission to Muckross House and Gardens within Killarney National Park, a beautifully preserved Victorian estate overlooking the lakes. Lunch is reserved at The Lake Room Restaurant in Killarney. The afternoon continues with the scenic route, allowing time for key photo stops along the Atlantic coastline. Dinner is arranged at The Lime Tree Restaurant. Overnight Killarney.

DAY 4

Cliffs of Moher & County Clare

Depart Killarney travelling north toward County Clare along the Wild Atlantic coast (approx. 3 hours). The morning is centred on timed-entry admission to the Cliffs of Moher Visitor Experience, where dramatic Atlantic views extend along Ireland's western seaboard. Lunch is reserved at The Falls Hotel Restaurant in Ennistymon, with flexibility to adjust timing based on travel pace. In the afternoon, a brief stop at Bunratty Castle is included for exterior viewing and photographs. Continue to Galway where dinner is arranged at Aniar Restaurant, celebrated for contemporary regional cuisine. Overnight Galway.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 5

Connemara & Atlantic Heritage

Travel west into the landscapes of Connemara, renowned for its rugged mountains and Atlantic scenery. The morning includes admission to Kylemore Abbey and Victorian Walled Gardens, a lakeside estate surrounded by dramatic mountain scenery. Lunch is reserved at Mitchell's Restaurant in Clifden, highlighting local seafood and regional produce. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the Connemara Heritage & History Centre, presenting the traditions and Gaelic culture of Ireland's west coast. Return to Galway where dinner is arranged at Ard Bia at Nimmos, overlooking Galway Bay. Overnight Galway.

DAY 6

Return to Dublin – Departure

Depart Galway travelling east toward Dublin Airport (approx. 2.5 hours). The morning includes admission to the Irish National Stud & Japanese Gardens, exploring Ireland's renowned thoroughbred heritage alongside its landscaped gardens. Lunch is reserved at The Green Barn Restaurant in County Kildare, timed to align comfortably with onward travel. Following lunch, continue directly to Dublin Airport via private transfer, ensuring a smooth and timely arrival for departure formalities.
