Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Cardiff Welsh Heritage

Arrival at Cardiff Airport where your driver guide welcomes the group and transfers them into the Welsh capital. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Cardiff Castle exploring the Norman keep, Victorian Gothic apartments, and historic grounds. Lunch is reserved at The Potted Pig Restaurant located within a historic bank vault in the city centre. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the National Museum Cardiff presenting Welsh art, natural history and archaeology followed by entry to St Fagans National Museum of History, an open air heritage museum showcasing traditional Welsh buildings. Dinner is arranged at Heaneys Restaurant. Overnight in Cardiff.

DAY 2

Brecon Beacons and Welsh Countryside

Depart Cardiff, travelling north into the landscapes of Brecon Beacons National Park. The morning includes admission to Brecon Cathedral and Heritage Centre, presenting the region's ecclesiastical history. Continue with entry to the National Showcaves Centre for Wales, exploring limestone caves and geological formations. Lunch is reserved at The Felin Fach Griffin Restaurant, known for countryside cuisine. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Penderyn Distillery Visitor Centre, where guided tours introduce Welsh whisky production. Dinner is arranged at Walnut Tree Restaurant near Abergavenny. Overnight in Brecon.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Snowdonia and North Wales Castles

Travel north through the countryside toward Snowdonia National Park. The morning features timed entry admission to Caernarfon Castle, one of Edward I's medieval fortresses and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lunch is reserved at The Black Boy Inn Restaurant in Caernarfon's historic centre. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Penrhyn Castle and Gardens, a National Trust estate overlooking the Menai Strait, followed by entry to the Snowdon Mountain Railway Visitor Experience, presenting the history of Wales mountain railway. Dinner is arranged at Pale Hall Restaurant. Overnight in Snowdonia.

DAY 4

Conwy and Departure

Depart Snowdonia, travelling east along the North Wales coast. The morning includes timed entry admission to Conwy Castle, one of the best-preserved medieval castles in Europe. Continue with entry to Plas Mawr Elizabethan Townhouse, a restored merchant residence offering insight into Tudor life. Lunch is reserved at The Groes Inn Restaurant, one of Wales' oldest inns, located within the Conwy Valley. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Bodnant Garden, a celebrated horticultural estate, before transfer to Manchester Airport for onward departure.
