Day by Day Programme

DAY 1

Arrival in Cardiff Historic Film Locations

Arrival at Cardiff Airport where your driver guide welcomes the group and transfers them into the Welsh capital, a frequent filming location for television and cinema. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Cardiff Castle whose Roman walls and Victorian interiors have appeared in historical productions. Lunch is reserved at The Potted Pig Restaurant in the city centre. In the afternoon enjoy admission to St Fagans National Museum of History an open air heritage site used for period filming followed by entry to the National Museum Cardiff. Dinner is arranged at Heaneys Restaurant. Overnight in Cardiff.

DAY 2

Brecon Beacons and Dramatic Landscapes

Depart Cardiff travelling north into the landscapes of Brecon Beacons National Park whose terrain has served as a cinematic backdrop. The morning begins with admission to the National Showcaves Centre for Wales exploring underground caverns and geological formations. Continue with entry to Brecon Cathedral and Heritage Centre presenting Welsh history. Lunch is reserved at The Felin Fach Griffin Restaurant known for countryside dining. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Penderyn Distillery Visitor Centre offering guided tours and tastings of Wales whisky. Dinner is arranged at The Walnut Tree Restaurant. Overnight in Brecon.



Day by Day Programme

DAY 3

Snowdonia and Legendary Castles

Travel north toward the landscapes of Snowdonia National Park. The morning features timed entry admission to Caernarfon Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage fortress used in historical film productions. Lunch is reserved at The Black Boy Inn Restaurant, a historic inn within the town's medieval walls. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Penrhyn Castle and Gardens overlooking the Menai Strait, followed by entry to the Snowdon Mountain Railway Visitor Centre, presenting the railway that climbs Wales's highest peak. Dinner is arranged at Pale Hall Restaurant. Overnight in Snowdonia.

DAY 4

Conwy Coast and Departure

Begin the final morning with timed entry admission to Conwy Castle, one of Britain's most visually impressive medieval fortresses. Continue with entry to Plas Mawr Elizabethan Townhouse, offering a preserved example of Tudor architecture. Lunch is reserved at The Groes Inn Restaurant located in the Conwy Valley. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Bodnant Garden, a National Trust estate with landscapes overlooking the river valley, before transferring to Manchester or Liverpool Airport for onward departure.
