## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 1

#### Arrival in Cardiff Capital Heritage

Arrival at Cardiff Airport where your driver guide welcomes the family and transfers them into the Welsh capital. The programme begins with timed entry admission to Cardiff Castle exploring Roman foundations the Norman keep and Victorian interiors designed by William Burges. Lunch is reserved at The Potted Pig Restaurant in the historic city centre. In the afternoon enjoy admission to the National Museum Cardiff presenting Welsh art and natural history collections followed by entry to St Fagans National Museum of History an open air museum showcasing traditional Welsh buildings and culture. Dinner is arranged at Heaneys Restaurant. Overnight in Cardiff.

### DAY 2

#### Brecon Beacons National Park

Depart Cardiff, travelling north into the landscapes of Brecon Beacons National Park. The morning includes admission to the National Showcaves Centre for Wales, exploring limestone caverns and underground formations. Continue with entry to Brecon Cathedral and Heritage Centre, presenting the region's ecclesiastical history and Welsh heritage. Lunch is reserved at The Felin Fach Griffin Restaurant, known for countryside dining. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Penderyn Distillery Visitor Centre, where guided tours introduce Welsh whisky production. Dinner is arranged at The Walnut Tree Restaurant. Overnight in Brecon.



## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 3

#### Snowdonia and North Wales Castles

Travel north through rural Wales toward Snowdonia National Park. The morning features timed entry admission to Caernarfon Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Edward I's most impressive medieval fortresses. Lunch is reserved at The Black Boy Inn Restaurant in Caernarfon's historic centre. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Penrhyn Castle and Gardens, a National Trust estate overlooking the Menai Strait, followed by entry to the Snowdon Mountain Railway Visitor Centre presenting the railway climbing Wales' highest mountain. Dinner is arranged at Pale Hall Restaurant. Overnight in Snowdonia.

### DAY 4

#### North Wales Coast and Historic Conwy

Begin the morning with timed entry admission to Conwy Castle, one of the best-preserved medieval castles in Europe, with defensive walls. Continue with entry to Plas Mawr Elizabethan Townhouse, a restored merchant residence illustrating Tudor life. Lunch is reserved at The Groes Inn Restaurant, one of Wales' oldest inns in the Conwy Valley. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Bodnant Garden overlooking the River Conwy, followed by a visit to the Conwy Suspension Bridge Exhibition. Dinner is arranged at The Castle Hotel Restaurant. Overnight in Conwy.



## Day by Day Programme

### DAY 5

#### Industrial Heritage and Mountain Landscapes

Depart the coast travelling south through the slate landscapes of Gwynedd. The morning includes admission to the National Slate Museum presenting the industrial heritage that shaped North Wales communities. Continue with entry to Llechwedd Slate Caverns where exhibitions and underground tours reveal the history of mining communities. Lunch is reserved at The Heights Restaurant in Llanberis overlooking Llyn Padarn. In the afternoon enjoy admission to Dolbadarn Castle a medieval tower with views across Snowdonia. Dinner is arranged at Pale Hall Restaurant. Overnight in Snowdonia.

### DAY 6

#### South Wales Castles and Departure

Depart Snowdonia, travelling south through the countryside toward Cardiff. The morning features timed entry admission to Caerphilly Castle, one of Britain's largest medieval fortresses, surrounded by defensive lakes. Continue with entry to Castell Coch, a Victorian castle set within woodland outside the capital. Lunch is reserved at The Old House Restaurant overlooking the countryside. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to Rhondda Heritage Park Mining Experience presenting Wales' industrial and cultural legacy before transfer to Cardiff Airport for onward departure.
